**NOTICE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDMENT
LOUISA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

The Louisa County Board of Supervisors will consider the following item on Monday, January 5, 2015, in the Louisa County Public Meeting Room, Main Floor, Louisa County Office Building, Louisa, Virginia:

Amendment and readoption of Article II—Fireworks of Chapter 42—Fire Prevention and Protection of the Louisa County Code. A recodification of Louisa County Code provisions relating to fireworks to transfer authority for approval of permits from the Commonwealth's Attorney to the Chief of Fire & Emergency Services. Other technical amendments are included. No substantive change is intended from current law on fireworks permits for public display.

A full text of the ordinance under consideration is available for review in the Office of the County Administrator, Upper Floor, Louisa County Office Building, Louisa, Virginia, during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 5:00 pm, or by calling (540) 967-3400. Appropriate amendments may be made to the text of the ordinance prior to adoption.
