**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
LOUISA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

The Louisa County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on the following items at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 19, 2016, in the Louisa County Public Meeting Room, Main Floor, Louisa County Office Building, Louisa, Virginia:

**Public Hearing – REZ2015-04; Louisa County Industrial Development Authority (C/O Bernie Estes, Chairman), Applicant/Owner; Andy Wade, Economic Development Director, Agent**

Louisa County Industrial Development Authority (c/o Bernie Estes, Chairman), Applicant/Owner; Andy Wade, Economic Development Director, Agent; requests an amendment to proffer #1 approved as a part of REZ2005-13 (amended REZ2012-02) to remove the proffered 100 foot buffer on the subject parcel only and to add proffer #11 to provide alternative setbacks and buffers to allow development of this parcel (TMP 42-4C). The property is located on the east side of Route 625 (Chalklevel Road), between the railroad tracks and Route 1199 (Resource Lane). The property is further identified as tax map parcel 42-4C, in the Mineral Magisterial District and Mineral Voting District. The 2012 Louisa County Comprehensive Plan designates this property for Community Service in the Louisa Designated Growth Area.

**Public Hearing - Pursuant to Virginia Code Section 15.2-2507 (A)**

The Louisa County Board of Supervisors states its intent to amend and adjust the aggregate amount to be appropriated during the current fiscal year in excess of one percent of the total expenditures. Public comment is invited to address consideration of a resolution authorizing a supplemental appropriation to the Fiscal Year 2016 budget to fund infrastructure required for broadband service in Louisa County. As a part of the project, ten towers will be strategically placed throughout the county to carry wireless signals to the majority of the County. Costs associated with this project is estimated to be \$1,100,000.
