**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
LOUISA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

The Louisa County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on the following items at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, March 21, 2016, in the Louisa County Public Meeting Room, Main Floor, Louisa County Office Building, Louisa, Virginia:

Public Hearing – Repealing Article III, Chapter 38 of the Louisa County Code “Biosolids”

The Louisa County Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the best interest of its citizens to deal with only one authority in all matters relating to biosolids; and that to re-vest the Commonwealth of Virginia with the authority to monitor and investigate complaints related to biosolids in Louisa County. For these reasons, the Board of Supervisors states it intent to repeal Section 38-81 through 38-86 of the Louisa County Code in its entirety.

Molina, Owners; requests the issuance of a special use permit for installation of a 70’ wooden pole (with antenna) in accordance with Section 86-482 Permitted uses for Freestanding WCFs Between Maximum District Height and 100’ (Parcel <25 Acres) in the Residential General (R-2) zoning district. The subject property is located on the northeast side of Route 652 (Kentucky Springs Road) and is designated as tax map parcel 29-51A in the Mineral Voting District. The 2012 Comprehensive Plan designates this area of Louisa County as Low Density Residential in the Lake Anna Designated Growth Area.
