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**NOTICE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS
LOUISA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

The Louisa County Board of Supervisors will consider the following item on Monday, April 20, 2015, in the Louisa County Public Meeting Room, Main Floor, Louisa County Office Building, Louisa, Virginia:

Louisa County Code Chapter 60 – Procurement. Repeals and replaces sections 60-1 through 60-47 of the Louisa County Code. A comprehensive revision and simplification of Louisa County Code Chapter 60 – Procurement to clarify that Louisa County will in general follow the default procedures of the Virginia Public Procurement Act. In accordance with Va. Code § 2.2-4303(G), adopts a local small purchase procedure in which formal competitive bidding or competitive negotiation is not necessary for contracts if the total value of which is less than \$30,000. This procedure is identical to current law for practical purposes. Contracts or purchases of \$1,000 or less would simply be purchased; contracts or purchases for \$1,000 to \$5,000 would be made based upon three or more telephone quotes; and contracts or purchases for \$5,000 to \$30,000 would be based upon three or more written quotes. Artificial division of contracts or purchases so as to make them small purchases would be prohibited. This amendment would have no effect on current procurement procedures, but would bring local code into compliance with state law.
