**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
LOUISA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

The Louisa County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on the following item at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, April 20, 2015, in the Louisa County Public Meeting Room, Main Floor, Louisa County Office Building, Louisa, Virginia:

Public Hearing - Proposed parcel boundary adjustment between parcels adjacent to the Spring Creek subdivision in the Green Springs Magisterial District of Louisa County, Virginia, for the purpose of facilitating use of reclaimed water for irrigation purposes. A boundary line between Tax Map Parcel 36-12B, on which the Louisa County Water Authority Spring Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant exists, and Tax Map Parcel 35-68, a parcel owned by the Virginia Sargeant Reynolds Foundation, would be moved to as to move 9.0 acres comprising an unnamed pond into Tax Map Parcel 35-68. A utility lot of 4.9 acres is proposed to be created, in accordance with the Louisa County Subdivision Ordinance, for storage of reclaimed water for use in irrigation. In furtherance of such uses, the County will give and receive various site development and utility easements. The County will also receive an option to purchase an easement for ingress and egress to and from the Spring Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant and Route 15, James Madison Highway. All monetary consideration is nominal.
