**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
LOUISA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

The Louisa County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on the following items at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 8, 2015, in the Louisa County Public Meeting Room, Main Floor, Louisa County Office Building, Louisa, Virginia:

**Public Hearing - SUP2015-02; iWisp, LLC, Applicant; LACD,LLC Owners; - Special Use Permit Request** - SUP2015-02; iWisp LLC, Applicant; LACD, LLC, Owner requests: The issuance of a special use permit for installation of a 93' (with antenna) lattice tower in accordance with Section 86-482 Permitted uses for Freestanding WCFs Between Maximum District Height and 100' (Parcel <25 Acres) in the General Commercial (C-2) zoning district. The subject property is located on tax map parcel 16-9-25, on the east side of Zachary Taylor Highway and on the north side of Shoreview Court, in the Mineral Voting District of Louisa County. The 2012 Comprehensive Plan designates this area of Louisa County as Community Service in the Lake Anna Designated Growth Area.

**Public Hearing** – Notice of intent that the Louisa County Board of Supervisors intends to abandon and relocate the section of Old County Road right-of-way west of CSX railroad and north and east of Pendleton Road, U.S. Route #522 along parcels 43-161 and 43-162. This section is an old undeveloped 30 feet wide right-of-way approximately 580 feet in length that has not been used for many years and not maintained by the Virginia Department of Transportation.

The right-of-way to be vacated will be relocated along the western edge of CSX Railroad beginning at Old County Road right-of-way to the north, parcels 43-161 and 43-162 to the west, and ending at Pendleton Road, U.S. Route #522 to the south. The previous abandonment of Old County Road right-of-way along CSX railroad at this location will be added to the total width to be no more than 50 feet provided to the county by the applicant.
