Recycling Features

Recycling is now made simple. For your Cardboard recycling, please utilize our new receptacles marked "Cardboard Only", and for all other recyclable material we use a single "Co-mingled" receptacle marked "Newspaper, Cans, Plastic, Glass".

Acceptable Materials:

CARDBOARD: Cardboard boxes

COMINGLE: Paperboard (i.e. cereal boxes), Aluminum & Tin Cans, Glass, Plastics, & Mixed Paper

OTHER: Used Motor Oil and Automobile Batteries

Unacceptable Materials:

Trash, Clothing, Styrofoam, Plastic Bags, Lids, Caps, Food, Compost, Yard Waste

DO:

- EMPTY & RINSE ALL CONTAINERS
- BOXES MUST BE BROKEN DOWN & FLATTENED

DO NOT:

- NO PLASTIC BAGS
- PLEASE DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLABLES

LANDFILL ONLY ITEMS: Antifreeze, appliances, brush, mulch, scrap metal, tires, usable soil, wood, commercial or business related waste.

Landfill Tipping Fees

Residential: 1,000 pounds per load at no charge. Any amount over the 1,000 pound limit is prorated at \$45 per ton.

Commercial: MSW, construction / demolition debris, industrial, scrap metal, brush is \$52 per ton

Tire Disposal

Type	Wheel Diameter	Fee
Dismounted	Up to 21 inch	\$2 each / residents four exempt per day
Dismounted	22 inch or greater	\$5 each
Mounted	Up to 21 inch	\$7 each
Mounted	22 inch or greater	\$20 each

Special Waste—Landfill

Item	Fee
Auto's, boats, utility trailers, pop-up campers	\$25 each and \$5 per mounted tire
Trailers, motor homes, tag-a-longs	Call for price information
Mobile homes	\$200 per section and \$5 per mounted tire
Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioning units, Freon	One unit free per load, then \$15 each
Lawn mowers, motors, gas or oil containing items	See attendant for proper handling
Latex paint (no charge if completely solidified)	\$5 per gallon or portion thereof
Oil based paint, roofing tar, sealants	\$5 per gallon or portion thereof
Drums, bulk containers	Accepted only by prior arrangement
