However, I saw little if anything regarding the preservation of the quality of life of residents living in R2 zoned residential neighborhoods. This is particularly true for R2 zones in the Lake Anna area. It appears that this area continues to be regarded as a source of revenue for the county, subject to increasing commercial and resort development without regard to the existence of residential neighborhoods. It seems to escape the county planners that there are an increasing number of housing developments in this area with citizens who have as much	<a href="#">View</a>

right to personal peace and privacy as residents in other parts of the county. The lack of attention to the quality of life for residents around the lake has lead to spot commercial zoning, unacceptable noise levels (fireworks and loud parties all summer), litter and trash, and inadequate police and fire protection. A significant contributor to the deteriorating conditions at the lake is the county turning a blind eye to the increasing vacation rentals and other business operations around the lake. There are at least four and possibly up to six vacation rentals near my neighborhood alone. Many of the lake rentals are money making businesses that offer rentals year round. Houses are being built with seven or more bedrooms, clearly with the intent of vacation rental. Other homes are increasingly being bought by investors for the same purpose. This is destroying the R2 neighborhoods and turning them into de-facto resort areas in contradiction to the distinction between R2 and commercial/resort development areas. Short term rental for profit is a business operation, but is apparently allowed, tongue in cheek, by the county as a by right use in an R2 zone. Many other jurisdictions limit short term rentals in residential areas to no less than some reasonable period, such as a month, for legitimate subletting of a home. Such jurisdictions recognize that short term rental are contrary to the purpose of a residential neighborhood. Again, apparently because county officials, developers, contractors and business owners prefer to not inhibit the growth of the vacation attraction of the lake, they ignore the erosion of the quality of life in R2 neighborhoods that the increasing commercialization of the lake is causing. Therefore, we who live in these neighborhoods have to deal with constant fireworks, parties, drunkenness, trash and litter, shoreline erosion from the constant wake producing activities, vandalism, and just incessant noise. The continuation of business as usual by the county with regard to zoning and development at the lake will

				make life for residents living there untenable. The Comprehensive Plan MUST address this issue directly. The county cannot continue to push for commercial and resort development at the lake without regard to the effect on tax paying citizens who reside in the R2 neighborhoods. At the very least, the county should act to keep business activities such as resort rentals within the resort and commercial development areas, and not treat R2 housing areas as extensions of resort development areas by virtue of proximity to the lake. This is unfair to the residents, and is counter to the intent of R2 zoning, which is to protect the quality of life for those living in these areas. The location of the R2 neighborhoods is irrelevant. Whether on the lake or not, they all have the same rights and expectations of being treated equally. While the goal of preserving the agricultural nature of the county is good, the county is becoming more and more residential. It is high time that the Comprehensive Plan recognize that fact and that there are many tax paying residents who live in the lake area.
